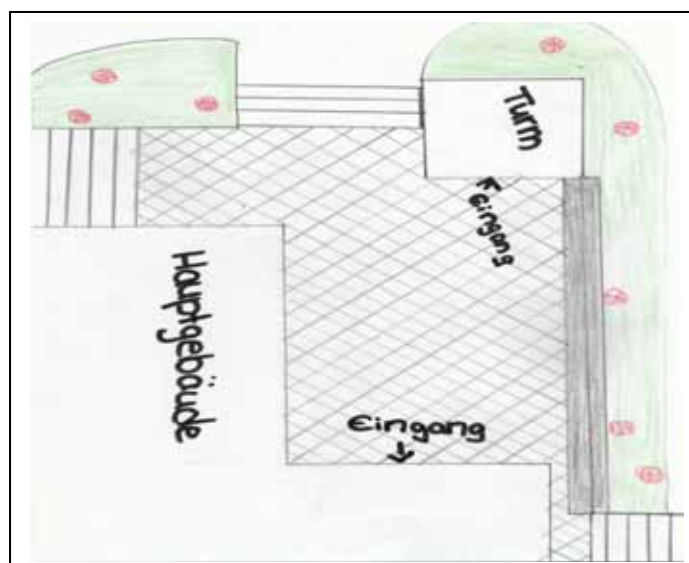
architect artist:

	Altar made of stone	<p>An altar is a place of worship for God. Sacrificial offerings are presented on this.</p> <p>But also the bare edification and/ or possibly rich decorations are an act of adoration.</p>
	Wooden figure of Resurrected Jesus	<p>Lateral to the baptismal font you can see a wooden figure of Jesus Christ. It pictures a resurrected Jesus Christ who appears to his disciples and shows them the stigmata in his hands.</p> <p>In his left hand he carries the cross as a sign of victory upon the death</p>
	Organ	<p>Most churches have an organ. The organist vamps the chants during the services and the introit and extroit</p>

	<p>Pictures /figures of saints</p> <p>Saint Barbara (wooden figure)</p>	<p>It is said that Barbara came from Nikomedia in Asia Minor, today's Turkey. She was born about 300 A.D. She wanted to make profession of Christianity but her father let her confine in a tower, let her torture and in the end kill. The miner's lamp shows that Saint Barbara is the patron saint of all miners.</p>
	<p>Baptismal font</p>	<p>The baptismal font belongs to the most essential features in a Christian church. As baptism means initiation into the Christian community and the parish, the baptismal font is often found in the entrance area of a church.</p>
	<p>Pictures /figures of saints</p> <p>Saint Martin</p>	<p>In 316 Martin was born as the son of a Roman army officer in Sabaria/ Hungary. Already as a child he learned to know about Christian beliefs. As an adult he worked as an army officer but retired from service to become a priest. He founded a monastery in the Province of Gaul and was appointed bishop in Tours/ France.</p>
