




Description

The church is dedicated to St. Ciril and Metod, and has five domes. The picturesque frescoes are made by Dragomir Jašević and Miša Mladenović. The author of the iconostasis is Mirko Šubic, of the icon is Jernej Jereb. The church is located in Prešeren Street in Ljubljana on the brinks of Tivoli Park. Nearby there are the National and the Modern Gallery.

The cultural-pastoral center is being built next to the church. There are 46,000 Serbian believers (which is 3% of all the population in Slovenia). Due to such a small number of church-goers, the church is not an autonomous in the regional aspect, but it forms a united metropolis together with the Serbian Orthodox Church in Croatia (Zagreb-Ljubljana).


